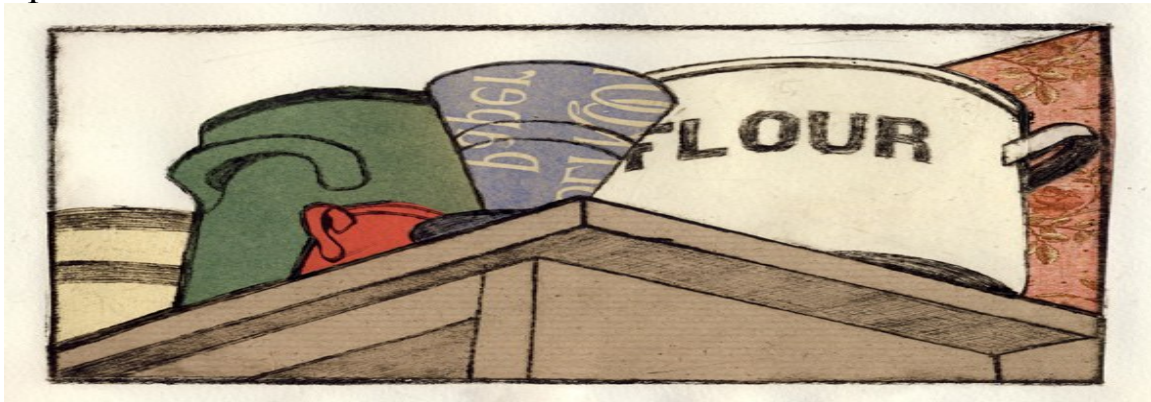
Topics Include:
